

Logging In

- Students will be able to log in using their school email and password
- Click 'Staff login' *(if you are already signed into your email account, it will let you in automatically)*
- Parents will receive an email in September with information on how to set a username and password (first two contacts on SIMS)

- Enable push notifications




We will use Epraise for:

Timetable

- Click the  icon in the top right corner



Homework

- Click 'Me' from the menu
- Click 'Planner'
- Your planner shows you all the work you've been set and that needs to be completed (you can also click on the tabs on the right to only see work 'Todo')
- Select the work you'd like to complete and choose to either:
 - download files
 - upload your files (once uploaded it will automatically be handed in so be sure it's the correct file)
 - if the work is to be done on paper, once completed select 'Not done' and it will change to 'Done'

Demerits

- Demerits are given if you do something wrong
- If you are given a demerit, you will automatically be alerted and so will your parent/carer

Points

- You are rewarded with points if you do something well or take part in something
- Points will carry over from years 7-13
- You can earn milestones with your points (badges and gems)
- You can spend your points in the school shop (your spendable points will be reset every year)

Rewards - Milestones

- Milestones are automatically achieved when you receive a certain number of points
- Years 7-9 will still receive badges for their blazers
- Gems will be awarded electronically on your profile

Rewards - Achievements

- You can earn achievements by taking part in events, activities or leadership opportunities
- These achievements can only be received if you have shown commitment **over time** and can only be awarded by the **member of staff in charge** of that area
- **You will receive points for every achievement!**

Rewards - Shop

- You can spend your points in the online shop
- Select 'Rewards' from the menu
- Click 'Shop'
- You will see a list of available items in the school shop. If you have enough points to purchase an item, you can click 'Buy'
- All tokens will need to be collected from the library
- Read the details for each purchase for important information on how to use it or where to collect an item
- If you have a suggestion for something you would like in the shop, click 'Suggestions' from the tabs on the right hand side

Interventions

- Interventions can be given as detentions, or as support sessions such as counselling, academic interventions, group work etc.


