

## SIXTH FORM HOMEWORK

- Detailed below is a **flexible** homework plan for sixth form students.
- Year 12 students should be provided with **approximately two to three hours** of weekly homework per subject.
- Year 13 students should be provided with **approximately four to five hours** of weekly homework per subject.
- Wherever possible, students should be provided with **at least one week** to complete the minimum hours of homework – if this is not possible, or if you are setting more than the minimum hours, please negotiate the deadline with the student(s).
- Sixth form students should be guided on how to work independently - for example, developing effective revision and/or research skills, and this should be monitored throughout the academic year.
